



Safe Exam Browser Guide

As part of your studies with William Academy, you will be using a lockdown browser called the Safe Exam Browser (SEB), which will provide a secure method for writing tests and exams. Many of your tests and exams at William Academy will be done through the Safe Exam Browser. Please take the time to read through the following guide so that you are prepared when it comes time to write a test or exam!

1. When the Safe Exam Browser is used for a test or exam on Moodle, you will find that there will be a Moodle quiz activity page associated with this test or exam. After clicking on the quiz page, you should see something similar to the following:




- You can click on the box in the red section above if you have not downloaded Safe Exam Browser before (it is recommended that you have it downloaded before you begin a real test or exam!).
- You can click on the box in the green section above if you have already downloaded Safe Exam Browser and are ready to write your test or exam!
- 2. Downloading Safe Exam Browser (if you have already downloaded and installed Safe Exam Browser, please skip to Step 4): If you are downloading it for the first time, after clicking on the box in the red section above, you should be directed to the following website: https://safeexambrowser.org/download_en.html. It should look something like the image below. Safe Exam Browser is currently supported on Windows, macOS, as well as iOS (not recommended). Make sure you are downloading the most recent version of Safe Exam Browser that is compatible with the operating system that your device is using!

- 3. After downloading Safe Exam Browser, make sure you **install** it on your device. You can install it by clicking "open" on the file that was downloaded from step 2. Once you have installed Safe Exam Browser, you can return to your Moodle quiz page.
- 4. To launch Safe Exam Browser and write your test or exam, click on the box in the green section from the picture in Step 1. It should open Safe Exam Browser and request for you to log in again with your Moodle log-in credentials. Please make sure that you are familiar with your login credentials! After logging in, you will be directed to the Moodle quiz page and asked to begin your test or exam.





- 5. The next steps of this guide will show you what Safe Exam Browser looks like after you start your test or exam!
- 6. Your test or exam will be on a Moodle quiz, and only accessible if you open it through the Safe Exam Browser. If you have ever completed a quiz activity on Moodle, it should look familiar to you. For tests or exams, there will be some instructions for you to follow (make sure you read them!), shown in the red box in the picture below.

In general, there should be several sections that will let you type in your responses to the test or exam questions, shown in the blue box in the picture below. There will also be a link for you to click to access your test or exam, shown in the green box in the picture below.



7. Once you click on the link to the test or exam, it should open a new window with your test or exam. You can resize your windows to your own preference. For example, the picture below shows an example orientation in the Safe Exam Browser, where the student has placed his exam on the right to refer to the questions (blue circle), and his Moodle quiz page on the left to enter his responses (red circle).



Once you have set up your screen like this, you should begin your test or exam and start answering the questions!

8. Once you finish your test or exam, please make sure you scroll all the way to the bottom to click to finish your attempt (green box in the picture below). Make sure you go through all the steps and confirmation prompts to ensure your submission was made properly.

Once you have submitted your test or exam, you can quit safe exam browser by clicking on the power button on the bottom-right of your screen. If you are requested for a quit password, your teacher or William Academy counselor will be able to provide it to you once they verify that your work has been submitted properly!
